Does GM offer the best coverage in America?

Yes. The combination of 100,000-Mile/5Yr. Powertrain Limited Warranty which is fully transferable with no deductible, plus 100,000-mile/5Yr. Courtesy Transportation and 24/7 Roadside Assistance makes it the best coverage in America.

Are customers who have already purchased a new 2007 GM car or light duty truck covered?

The 100,000-Mile Powertrain Limited Warranty is applicable on all 2007 model year vehicles including those sold before the announcement. Your customers who purchased a 2007 model year car or light-duty truck prior to September 7, 2006, will receive a letter in September and a warranty booklet insert explaining complete details of their new coverage.

What about customers who purchased GMPP/SSP plans?

Customers who previously purchased a 2007 GM vehicle with a GMPP or SSP will receive two letters. The first letter, mailed in September 2006, will notify them of the increase to the GM Powertrain Limited Warranty. The second letter, which will mail within 6-8 weeks from the GMPP or SSP team, will contain additional detail on how the new GM 100,000-Mile Warranty impacts their GM Protection Plan or the Saturn Service Plan contract.
